One-on-One Coaching Sessions:

- UCF faculty and staff can encourage and/or mandate a student to complete a one-on-one coaching session with a representative from the IED office
- Coaching session topics can be centered on a particular situation a UCF Knight is currently facing examples include the following:
 - ❖ A student has sent an inappropriate email containing disrespectful language and/or is lacking a sense of professionalism
 - ❖ A student is having a difficult time making a decision regarding academic and/or personal life choices
 - ❖ A student has demonstrated an inability to handle anger in regards to critical feedback
 - ❖ Students have been assigned a group project and assistance is needed in handling group dynamics for successful completion of the assignment
- One-on-one coaching sessions can be tailored toward ethical decision-making, email/classroom etiquette, conflict management, group dynamics, problem solving, and/or anger management
- Documentation can be provided regarding successful completion of a coaching session but for confidentiality reasons, details of the session cannot be released
- One-on-one appointment can be scheduled by calling the IED office
- IED will travel to a Regional Campus, the Rosen Campus and the UCF Medical School to conduct an one-on-one coaching session
