

Academic Integrity Coaching Session

- Students found in-violation of academic misconduct are sanctioned from the Office of Student Conduct to complete an online academic integrity seminar.
- Students are then required to complete a one-on-one coaching session with a member of the IED staff to review their responses and develop strategies for demonstrating academic integrity.
- Coaching session discussions include stress associated with academic performance, meeting expectations of others, and pressures associated with perfectionism.

Academic Integrity Workshop

- An opportunity for UCF students to develop and create ethical standards which will empower them to practice and defend both personal and academic honesty.
- Students participate in conversations regarding university ethical standards which will provide an understanding of academic and campus cultures.
- Students are referred for participation by the Office of Student Conduct.
